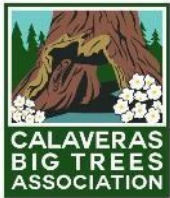


HELP SUPPORT CALAVERAS BIG TREES

These programs are made possible by the efforts of **Calaveras Big Trees Association.**

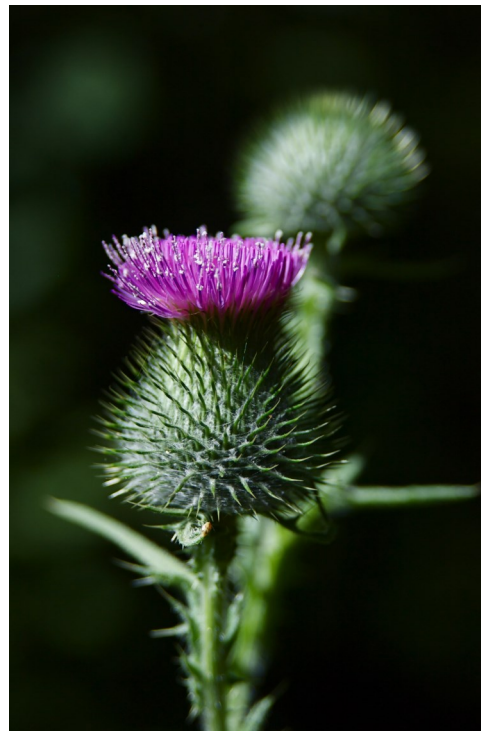
